

The Board of Ethics consists of 5 members of the general public who are not personally subject to this code of ethics. The members shall be appointed and serve at the pleasure of Council and shall serve 4-year terms. The Board will recommend orders, rules, regulations to the Code of Ethics. They shall investigate and render advisory opinions to City employees and appointed officials. They shall investigate any alleged violation of the code by employees or elected officials. The Board of Ethics is not empowered to take direct administrative action, but rather, its function shall be solely advisory.
