

The thrill of the new amusement park was the wooden rollercoaster called "The Flying Dragon". The park also offered a two-story waterslide, two boardwalks, speed boat rides, a bathhouse to change in, and many other attractions. People would come from miles around to spend the day picnicking, swimming, and enjoying all the excitement the park had to offer. There was also a dance pavilion that brought in many big name bands and singers from the 20's through to the early 60's.
