PUBLIC INFO MEETING IS WEDNESDAY, OCT. 24, FOR DIXBORO ROAD PAVING

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with Lyon Township, South Lyon and Green Oak Township, will host a public information meeting Wednesday, Oct. 24, to share information about the Dixboro Road gravel-road paving project, from 8 Mile Road to 9 Mile Road. Construction is expected to start in September 2019.

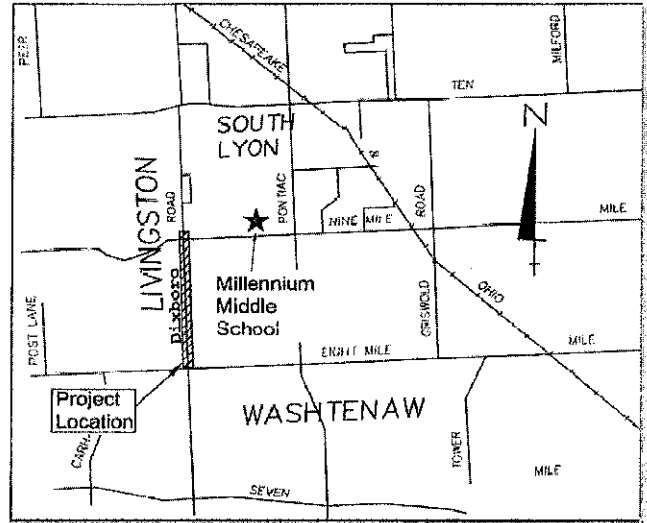
MEETING DETAILS

WHAT: Public information meeting to discuss the construction plans and the impact on traffic during construction.

WHEN: Wednesday, Oct. 24

WHERE: Millennium Middle School cafeteria -- 61526 9 Mile Road, South Lyon, MI 48178

NOTE: The meeting will be "open house" format. There will not be a formal presentation. Anyone can attend any time between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. to review information and speak with an RCOC representative.



PROJECT DETAILS

This project involves paving Dixboro Road from 8 Mile Road to 9 Mile Road. It also includes the construction of concrete curbs and gutters, improved roadway drainage and the replacement of twin culverts under the road.

IMPACT ON TRAFFIC AND SCHEDULE

During construction, Dixboro Road will be closed to through traffic between 8 Mile and 9 Mile roads. The detour will be 8 Mile Road to Pontiac Trail to 9 Mile Road, back to Dixboro Road and vice versa.

Access to properties along this section of Dixboro Road will be maintained at all times during the project.

The project will start in September 2019, but work will stop in the winter and resume in spring 2020, with the road expected to be open by the end of August 2020.

FUNDING

This project is expected to cost approximately \$2.5 million. Federal funding will cover 80 percent of the cost, with the remaining 20 percent being shared between RCOC, Lyon and Green Oak townships and Oakland County general government (through the Tri-Party Program).
