

The Housing Commission consists of 5 members and are appointed by the Mayor with approval of Council. They shall serve 5-year terms. The commission shall meet at regular intervals, and meetings will be public. Three members shall constitute a quorum. A president and vice president shall be elected by the commission. The commission shall determine in what areas of the City it is necessary to provide proper sanitary housing facilities for families of low income and for the elimination of housing conditions which are detrimental to the public peace, health, safety and or welfare. The commission shall establish and revise rents of any housing project or projects but shall rent all property for such sums as will make them self-supporting. To rent only to such tenants as are unable to pay for more expensive housing accommodations. Please see city code for more information.
